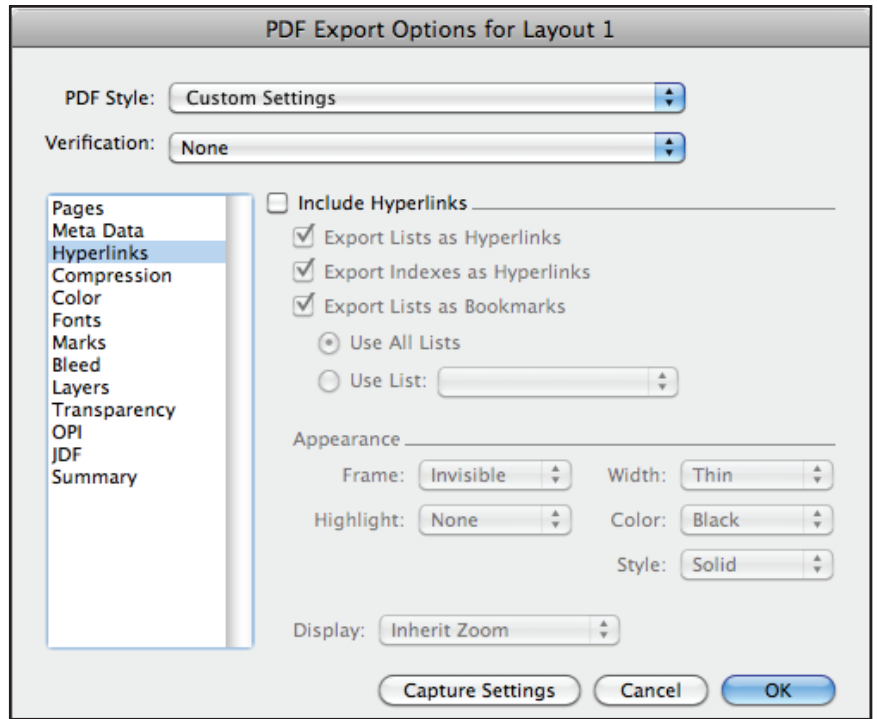
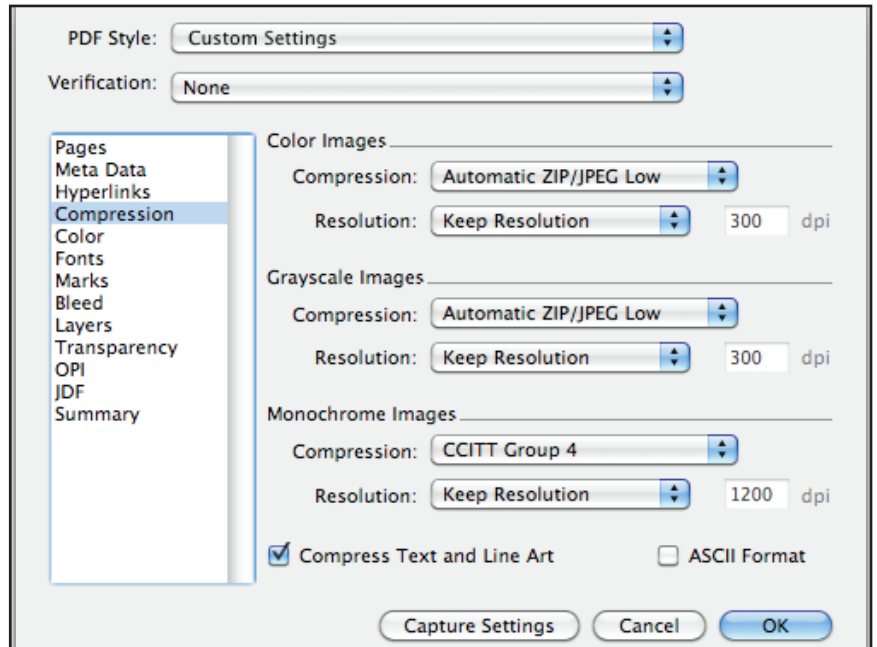

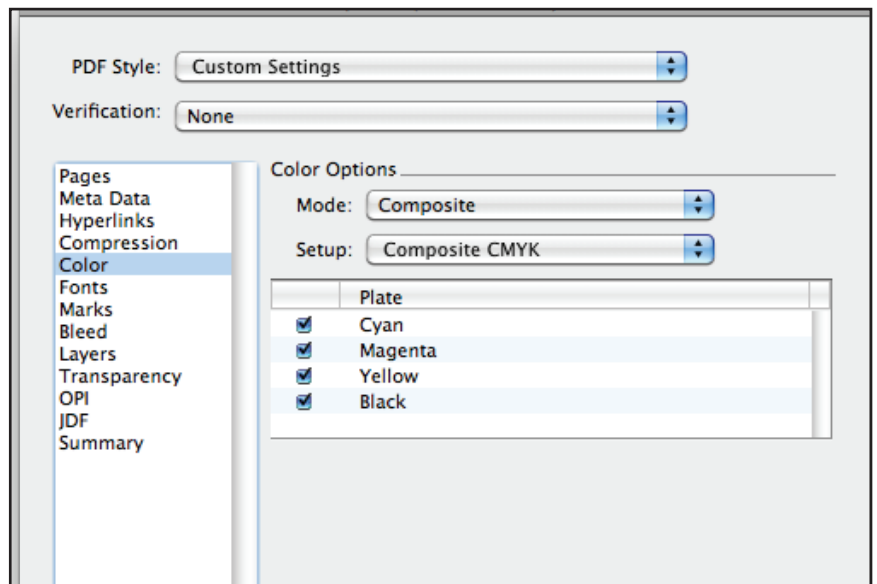
File - Export - Layout as PDF



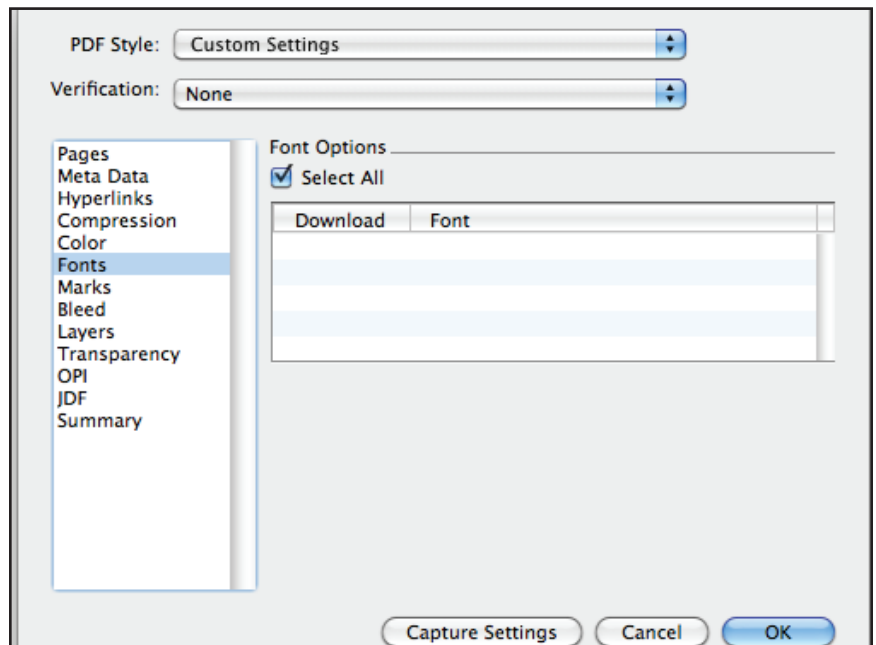
Compression should be set to low. Low compression means maximum quality.



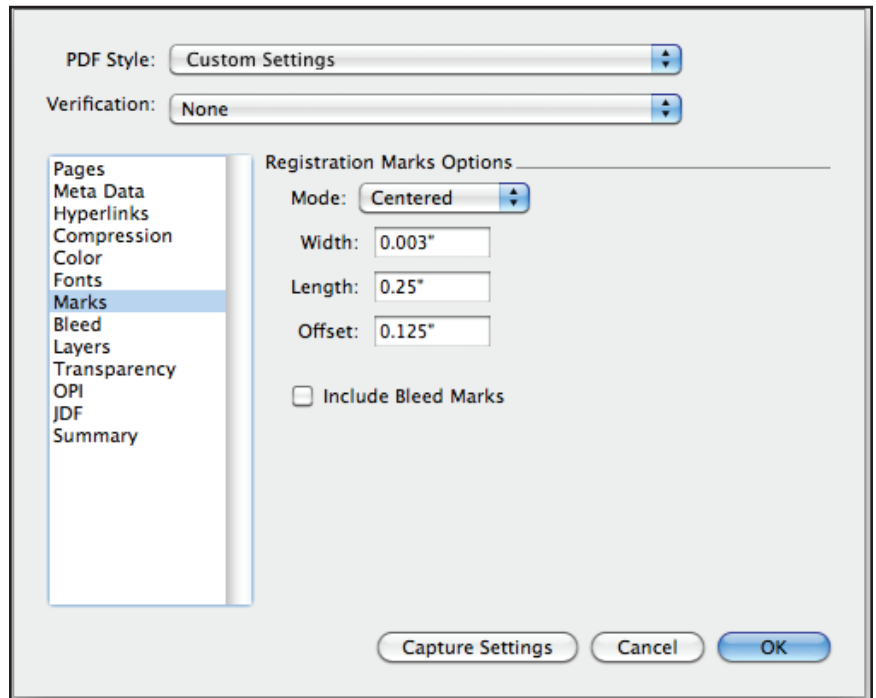
If your job is printing as a spot color choose:
Mode - Composite
Setup - Composite CMYK and SPOT



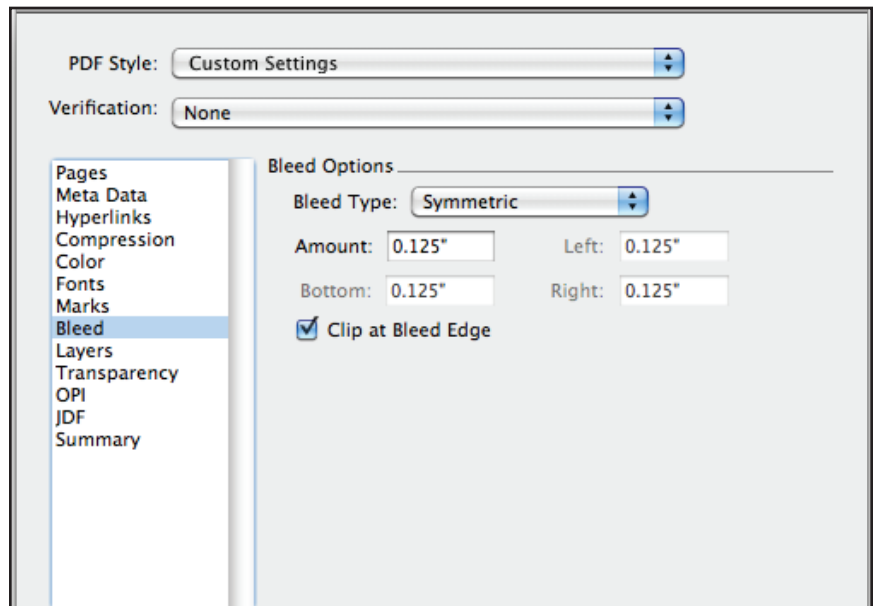
Select all to embed the fonts used.

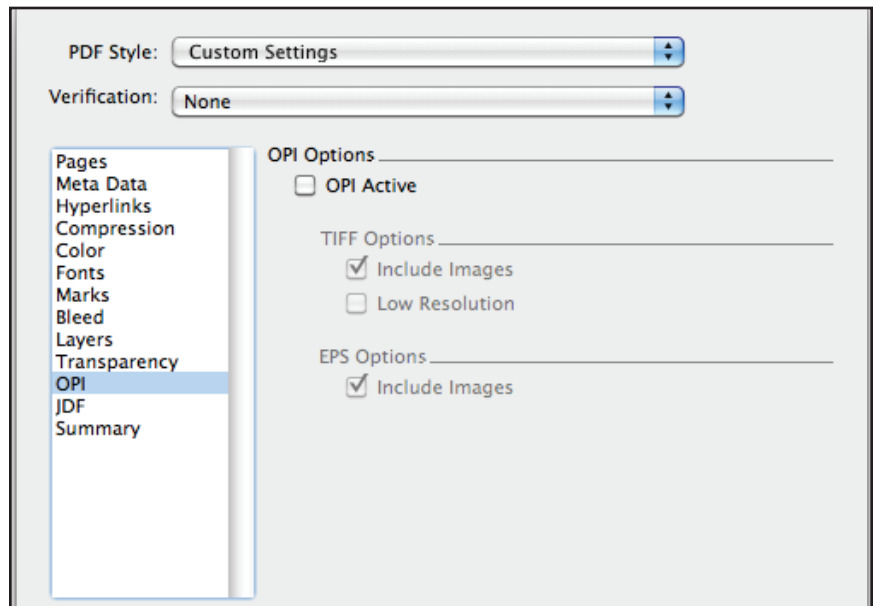
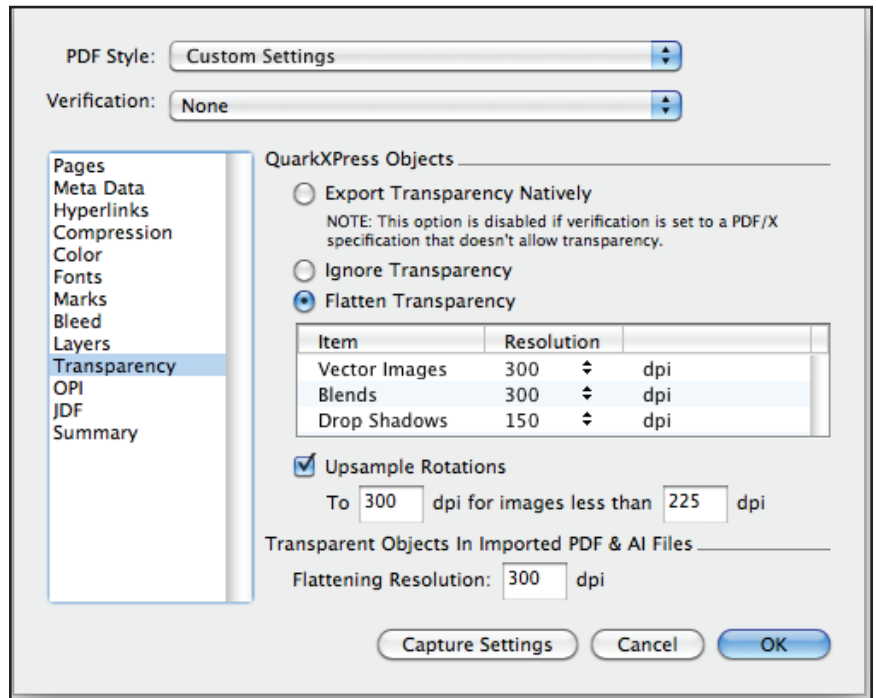
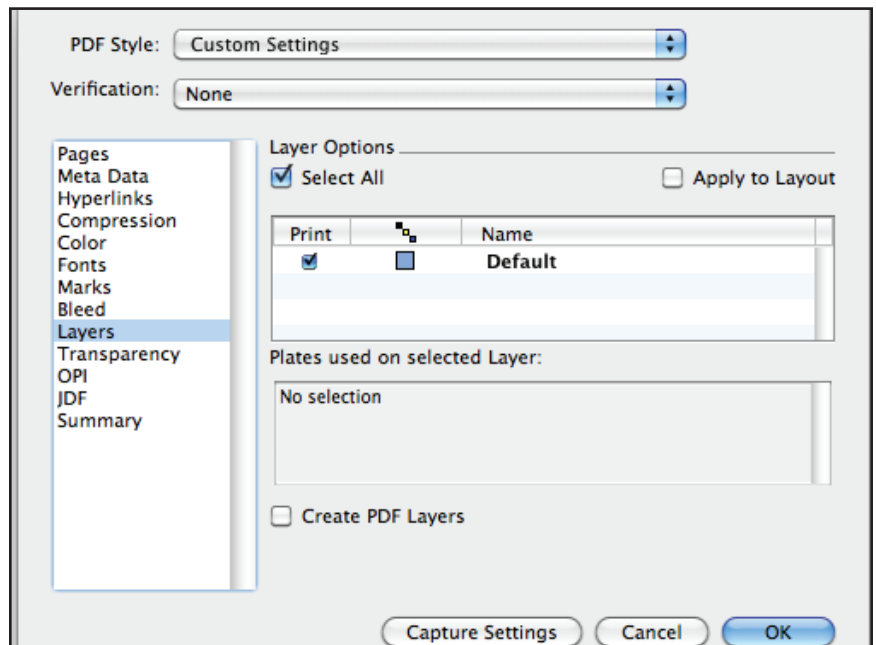


Setting the crop marks helps us see what the final size of your art is.



If your file has bleed this step is VERY important! 1/8" bleed is standard.





If you select the PDF style drop down menu you can save this setting.
